Leadership: Implementing the Common Core State Standards

Welcome to *Leadership: Implementing the Common Core State Standards* (CCSS), a course designed to support school and district leaders in bringing the CCSS to life in all classrooms. In this course, you will develop a clear vision of what implementation will look like in your setting and learn about essential implementation tools tied directly to the Common Core standards: formative and interim assessment, analysis and planning, leading professional development, evidence walks, and data dialogues. You will have the opportunity to reflect on your own practices, try out new approaches, and plan your strategies for effectively implementing the CCSS.

By the end of this course, you will have a deeper understanding of your role as a leader of Common Core implementation and new tools to help your school or district move toward the point where all graduates are college and career ready.

- Interpret the CCSS for English language arts and literacy and mathematics to understand the implications for instruction.
- Create a vision of effective implementation, using a Common Core Standards Configuration Map.

- Use a standards-linking process for action planning to plan implementation of the CCSS.
- Compare the vision developed in Module 1 to the current state of implementation in the school or district.

Module 3

- Analyze and use guidelines for interim assessments tied to the CCSS.
- Analyze and use criteria for formative assessments tied to the CCSS.
- Analyze samples of state assessment items tied to the CCSS.

Module 4

- Set priorities for data use.
- Plan for local engagements about data for improving student learning in relation to the CCSS.

Module 5

- Consider similarities and differences among three types of classroom visitation: classroom walk-throughs, instructional rounds, and evidence walks.
- Adapt or design an evidence walk template based on the CCSS shifts.

Module 6

- Use a CCSS professional learning team protocol.
- Recognize essential approaches to professional development for implementing the CCSS.
